Remember to check the condition of your grips in the wet winter conditions. If the condition of your grips are not up to scratch it could affect your ball striking ability and ultimately your score on a round of golf.

So, if your grips are not up to scratch, pop in to the pro shop to look at a various options for replacement grips to get you back on top of your game.

Pro Tip

Who's using a SW for chipping? I get a lot of people saying that a SW is only for the bunker.....

This is definitely not the case.

A SW or a 56 degree (same thing) is the most versatile club in your bag.

A sand wedge can used for chipping low and chipping high. The best part about using more loft in winter is you can fly it to the hole and stop it. This takes out all wet ground between you and the hole.

If you are not sure about how to use a SW around the green give Emma, Blake, Hamish or Luke a ring and book in a lesson.

This could save you many shots.
